

**What's in Your Wallet?**  
**Discussion**  
**1 Timothy 6:6-10**  
**November 11, 2018**

**Scripture Focus:** The Bible talks a lot about money and its power in us and over us. Let's look at what we can learn from God about how we are supposed to handle our money before money starts to handle us.

**Opening Prayer Focus:** We learn about money at a very young age. Pray that balance can be found between wanting more and managing what we currently have. Seek biblical responsibility with all God gives us, including money.

**Read:** 1 Timothy 6:6-10

**Things to Discuss:**

- How can we find "great wealth in things other than money?"
- What does contentment look like for you? What do you need to be content each day, how about over the course of a year? (1 Tim 6:8)
- When do you find yourself wanting more money, more income...what is it usually for? Have you ever been close to that place where money has brought you near to "ruin and destruction?" (1 Tim. 6:9)
- How can money make you sad or happy? Can you be happy and poor, can you be sad and rich at the same time? What are some things that people are willing to do for money that could be seen as evil? How can you prevent yourself from falling into that place?

**Closing Prayer focus:** Pray that contentment can be found outside of money. Lift up each person and ask God to remind us that what we have in Jesus is enough and that chasing after money can bring disaster to our lives. Pray for wisdom and balance with our finances.
