

# Vision Sunday

Romans 12:9-18  
November 24, 2019

**Opening Prayer:** As a group or a family, ask God to guide our church into the future according to His plans, rather than our plans. Let us pray that God would give us a clear picture of what the future can look like if we continue to follow the leadership of the Holy Spirit. Pray that we would submit to all God has for us as individuals, as families, and as a church.

## **Breaking the Ice:**

- Have you ever gone on vacation with an idea of what things would look like when you got there? Maybe it was something like the Grand Canyon and your imagination was so small compared to the vast beauty of the actual place. What was your experience...share it with the group?
- What does your own personal future look like? Do you have a job change, a family change, retirement, additional schooling, or something coming your future? What does it look like to you right now? What picture do you have in your mind about the changes that are coming?

## **Wrestling with the Word:**

Read Romans 12:9-18

- The Bible reminds us that we are called to love in exceptional ways. How does verses 9 and 10 tell us how love is supposed to look?
- A guide to living out our loves can be found in verses 11-18. How does this inform your everyday living, how you treat others, and how you should think about the situations in your life?
- If the Church of Jesus is going to survive into the future, this passage tells us that we must live differently than most of the world around us. What things can we do differently that will attract people to be a part of the CrossPoint family?

**Prayer for the Week:** Pray that God reveals a Kingdom sized vision to our church for the future. God has a part of all of us in His Kingdom...pray that we can find that place and live it out with integrity and faith. Pray for the future of our church and that God would bring about His vision for us.
