Breaking the Ice:

Wrestling with the Word:

Read John 1:1-14

- The Bible reminds us that Jesus came into the "world" and not just to us or our neighborhood. How does John 1 remind you of the challenge that Jesus took upon himself?
- What is one thing you, your group, your family or our church do to reach around the world on behalf of Jesus?
- If the message of Jesus is going to travel worldwide, what must we do differently that will reach the world around us? What things can we do differently that will attract people to be a part of the Christian faith?

Prayer for the Week: Pray that God would continue to call people to the larger mission of reaching the world. Pray for missionaries and workers who have left their homes and families and traveled to faraway places to share the message of God's love to others.
