## The Big Thing About Small Groups

Acts 2:42-43; Acts 5:42

February 16, 2020

**Opening Prayer:** As a group or a family pray that you can set a goal of finding a small group just for you. Pray that God will give you the strength to live up to being a devoted believer. Ask the Lord to make 2020 the year that you start getting involved in a small group. Pray that being in a small group will help the development of your faith.

### Breaking the Ice:

- Tell the group about what you like about your life group.
- What do you get out of going to a small/life group?
- How does being in a small group help your faith develop?
- What are some things that you can do by yourself and some things that you need help from others to accomplish?

### Wrestling with the Word:

Read Acts 2:42-43; Acts 5:42

- Why did the believers devote themselves to the apostles' teaching, fellowship and to sharing their faith in meals?
- How do you think that from being in a small group, a "deep sense of awe" would come of you?
- In Acts: 5, the apostles continued to "preach the message: Jesus is the Messiah." Why do you think they kept going out house to house to keep preaching?

**Prayer for the Week:** Pray that God would show you and your family how you can be part of a small group (if you're already in one that's great!). Ask God to be present when you go into those small groups. Pray that you are able to take time out of your day just for God. Pray that you're able to choose a small group and interact with them daily, making sure that everyone is taking time out for God.
